## **KICS REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION**

Proof of legal requirements to live in Rwanda: In accordance with a new Rwandan law on Immigration and Emigration (Law No 04/2011 of 21/03/2011, Article 19), KICS is required to have proof that each student has met the legal requirements to stay in Rwanda. Each student must submit a copy of either: 1) (Rwandan Citizens) The student's Rwandan Passport or other proof

of citizenship OR The visa page from the student's passport showing a valid Rwandan resident visa This document must be in each student's file within the first two weeks of attending class for the 2011-2012 school year. Students not eligible to study in Rwanda KICS pose a liability to the school and will be given a limited time to provide the necessary documentation.

PSAT Testing will be conducted on campus Wednesday, 12 October during school. It will be administered to all students in grades 10 and 11. The PSAT is designed to prepare students for taking the SAT Test in grades 11 and 12. There is a fee of 5,000RWF (the school is subsidizing the rest of the cost) that may be paid at the Reception Desk by Monday, October 10. Information packets were sent home on Friday. ## SCHOOL START and END TIMES

**SPECIAL NOTE:** With the numerous After School Activity options available this year, siblings of participants often wait after school until their sibling has completed their activity.
